

SHOW RULES

PLEASE READ COMPLETELY **(You must be a current member to participate)**

- Artists must display their art and maintain their spaces in a professional manner. Artists must not create a hazard to the public, other artists, or themselves. All packing materials, boxes, and items not part of your art display must be covered or returned to your vehicle.
- Crafts, jewelry, clothing, et.al., are not allowed.
- Artwork on display panels must be framed, matted, or canvas gallery-wrapped and finished along the sides. **Artwork must be created by the participant.** Reproductions must be marked as such.
- 10x10 Tents can be used but must be secured and weighted down. There can be wind gusts, We suggest using weights on the tent frame. Sides can be used as well.
- Umbrellas can also be used but must be secured with weights and cannot obstruct foot traffic.
- Display frames may be any reasonable height, and are allowed along the back or sides of the space, provided there is no disruption to public access ways. A-Frames are preferred, but other configurations are acceptable with prior approval of the DPFAA President or Harbor Shows Chair Person.
- A table of any reasonable size (*with tablecloth that must hang to the ground*), chairs, and bins are acceptable. **No artwork may be placed on the concrete or propped against objects, easels, tables, bins, columns, etc.**
- Artists must keep all equipment inside the concrete walkway score line near the center of the walk, and within the side perimeter lines of the exhibit space. Sufficient room (a minimum of 30-inches) shall be maintained between adjacent spaces to allow viewing access for the public. This means that each artist may need to provide about 15-inches of space toward this mutually shared corridor.
- Artist must be completely set up by **9:30 a.m.** and must stay until the show's end (5:00 p.m., in most cases). Breakdown of setups before 5:00 pm is not allowed. Should there be special circumstances regarding these times, see the Show Chairman or President.
- Artists will be charged 10% commission on all sales made. **The funds will be collected on the last day artist shows.** Envelopes will be provided.
- Pet animals are not allowed.
- Security will be provided on Saturday night, so artwork can be left inside secured tent (Sides should be used) or covered A-frames at artist's discretion.
- **Artists in Section 3**, must park in a parking space to unload/load and then remove car to appointed parking.

Artists must comply with all show rules as stated above. For non-compliance, an artist may be asked to leave the show and may be prohibited from participating in future shows sponsored by the Dana Point Fine Arts Association.
